

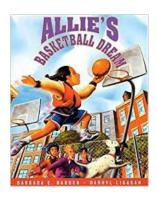


Dear Friend,

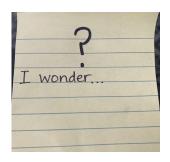

How You Can Use Post-its to Show Your Thinking:



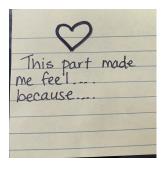
SKETCH A PICTURE

.....when you picture something in your mind.



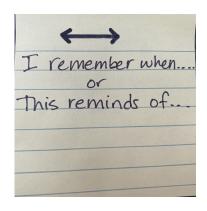
PLACE A QUESTION MARK

• PLACE SIDEWAYS ARROWS

.....when you have a connection. WRITE what your connection is to that part of the story.
